b school Allenbach started in 2015/16 with first- and second-year students as an alternative elementary school equivalent to state schools.

WHAT WE OFFER

bilingualism – “fit for the World”

- English as a second “mother tongue”
- approximately 50% of the school day done in English
- native-speaker quality during lessons

- Inter-grade lessons (classes 1 to 4) based on **Montessori principles** enable self-directed student learning to preserve children’s pleasure in learning.

Objectives of b school

We wish to enable children to lead a happy and successful life! That is why we focus on developing their potential and fostering their personal development as best we can.

OBJECTIVES AND POINTS OF FOCUS

- Create a **natural transition** from kindergarten to elementary as well as secondary schools
- Encourage children's **innate sense of curiosity** and joy of learning
- Foster **individual problem-solving skills** and personal commitment
- **All children** – irrespective of their physical or mental abilities – learn together in their school community.
- **Children with special talents and skills** (skilled and highly-skilled) receive assistance and enrichment.
- **Multilingual children** from internationally mobile families will be integrated according to their specific competences.

What does a school day look like?

b school offers dynamic, age-appropriate schooling. Morning and afternoon activities at school are connected in terms of content and personnel.

ELEMENTS OF DAILY ROUTINE

- Optional early morning care
- **Regular school hours** from 8 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
- **Tuesday is “school day”** until about 3 p.m. All the children and learning guides have lunch together and there is time for common school projects.
- **Wednesdays and Thursdays** all 3rd and 4th classes have lessons until 3 p.m.
- Optional care: lunch club until 1.15 p.m. or optional all-day care 'OGS' from the final lesson to 4.30 p.m. (Fridays until 2.30 p.m.)
- Homework is given on short school days only. There is reading and playing every day! Specific needs for enrichment are considered individually.
